Transitional Age Youth (TAY) Need Statement

DESCRIPTION:

The TAY program is a free mentoring and supportive service provided to youth ages 16 to 25 utilizing the Transition to Independence (TIP) Model. Services include case management and goal setting related to – Education, Parenting Skills, Social Supports, Physical Health, Community Engagement, Employment, Financial Planning, Emotional Wellbeing and Housing.

NEEDS:

- Walmart Gift Cards: \$25 (x15)
